Central Indiana Existing New York Central Depots

The railroad depot, the railroad office from big cities to small hamlets is the place where the traveling public to the local merchants interacted one on one with representatives of the railroad. Depot types included passenger only, freight depots and combination where both passenger and less than carload freight was handled. In the 60 plus years that most have seen a train stop at the platform, most no longer serve the railroad, having been sold and repurposed.

Francis H. Parker's book, Indiana Railroad Depots: A Threatened Heritage (Ball State University 1989) points out that nearly 25% of Indiana's railroad depots in 1976 were lost by 1986. An informal survey conducted in preparation of this list identifies an additional 30% were lost in the intervening almost 40 years. In the 50 years since the 1976 survey half of the depots have been lost. Still today the local railroad depot is still a threated species.

Below is a list of known New York Central System including Lake Erie & Western (which was sold to the Nickel Plate in 1922) depots in existence in Central Indiana. Please respect private property and remember that railroad property is private property. All photos by Seth Lakin except as noted.
